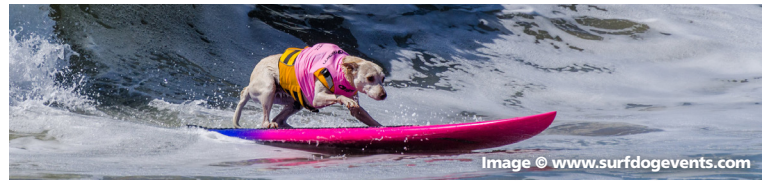
Sep. 28, Cruisin’ for a Cure Car Show
